Three evening online seminars will then follow to cascade the strategic approach down into the unions and their branches. This will be suitable for Branch Officers and activists and develop some new thinking.

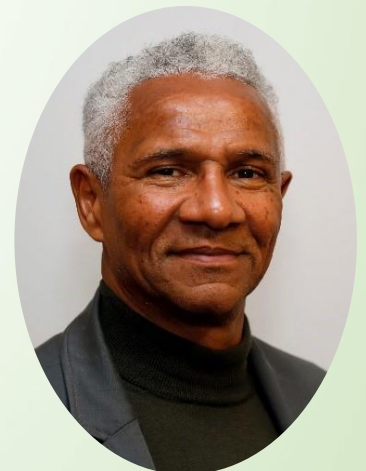
These will take place on **September 8th 7-9pm, September 22nd 7-9pm and October 6th 7-9pm.**
